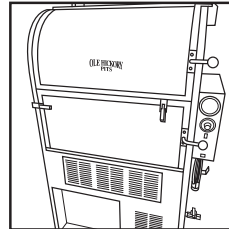
1 Make sure switches are off & connect power



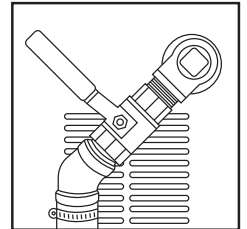
2 Ensure gas line is connected properly



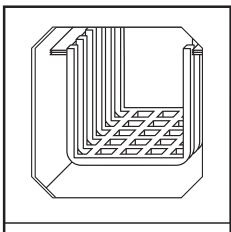

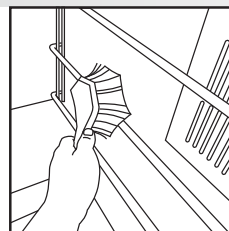
1 Open door



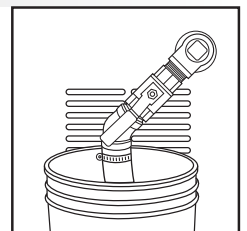
2 Remove rack & clean with soft bristle brush



3 Spray degreaser

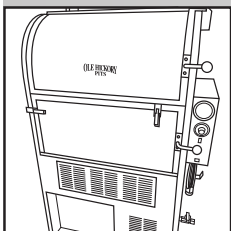


4 Brush clean with soft bristle brush & rinse

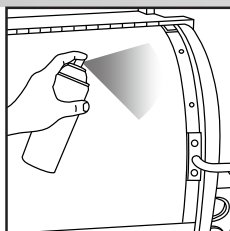


5 Drain grease & remove any meat chunks from bottom

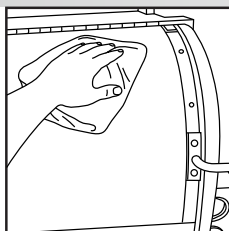
CLEAN OUTSIDE OF SMOKER



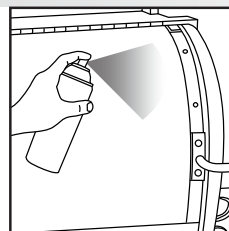
6 Wipe off dust, dirt & grease



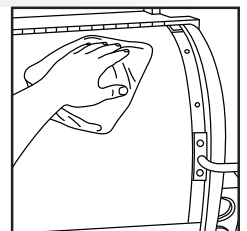
7 Spray stainless steel cleaner



8 Wipe clean with non-abrasive towel



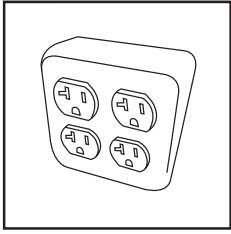
9 Spray polish



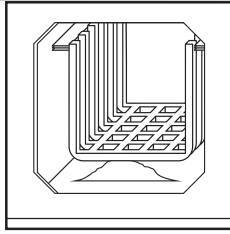
10 Wipe dry with non-abrasive towel

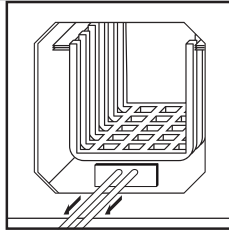

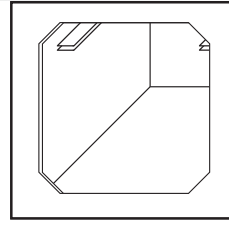
1 Unplug smoker before maintenance



2 Open fire box & cool

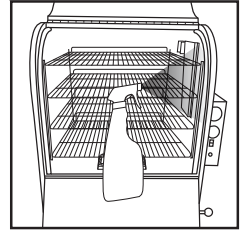


3 Remove wood shelf



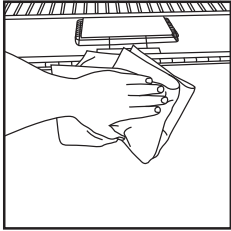
4 Clean & avoid getting ashes in burner tube

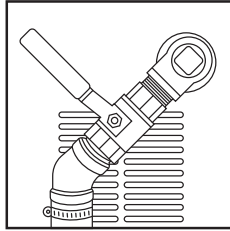
5 Spray degreaser on gaskets

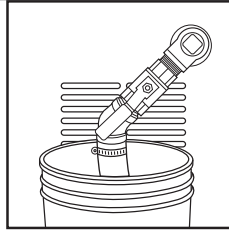


6 Wipe gaskets clean with non-abrasive towel

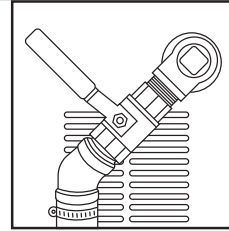

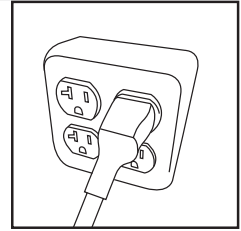
7 Remove chunks & open valve to drain grease



8 Drain grease into approved container using flex hose



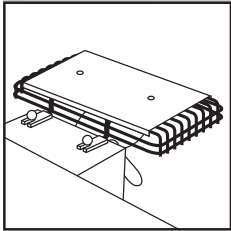

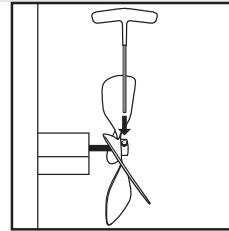
1 Locate fan cover



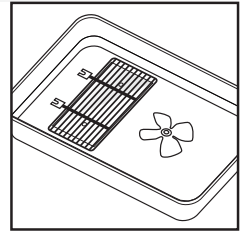
2 Loosen thumb screws



3 Remove cover

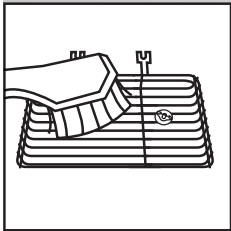


4 Remove fan blade with $\frac{3}{32}$ T-handle Allen wrench

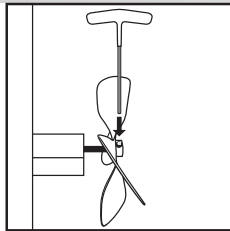


5 Soak & clean blade & cover

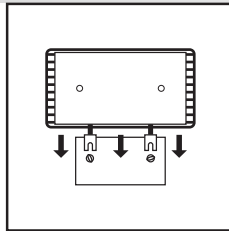
UNPLUG SMOKER & CLEAN FAN BLADE



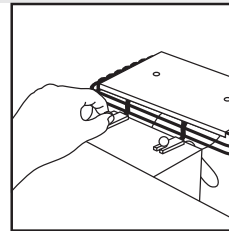
6 Clean cover with soft bristle brush



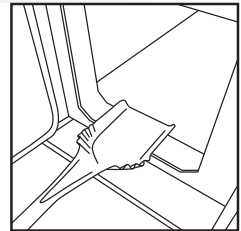
7 Install fan blade w/ $\frac{3}{32}$ T-handle, hub faces away from motor



8 Install cover

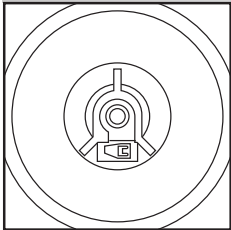


9 Tighten thumb screws

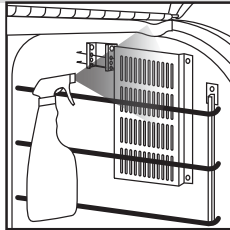


10 Remove ash with ash shovel

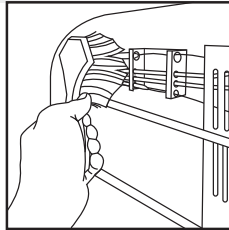
CLEAN SENSOR PROBES



11 Inspect burner tube with mirror & remove ash

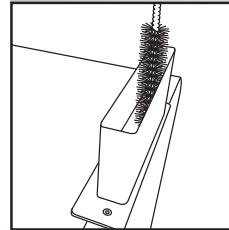


12 Spray cleaner carefully

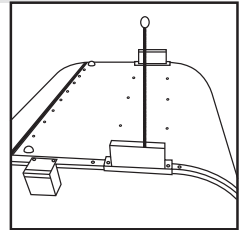


13 Use soft bristle brush to clean probes

14 Insert flue brush all the way down to handle to remove build up



15 Clean both flue pipes frequently
